



## Apple iOS Remote Wipe Instructions

First, open up your iPhone and make sure Find My iPhone is enabled inside your Settings app, then the iCloud tab. This should be done immediately in order to ensure that in case of emergency, your iPhone can be locked and/or wiped remotely.





Once that's set up, go to [iCloud.com](https://www.icloud.com) and sign in using the Apple ID you use on your iPhone.

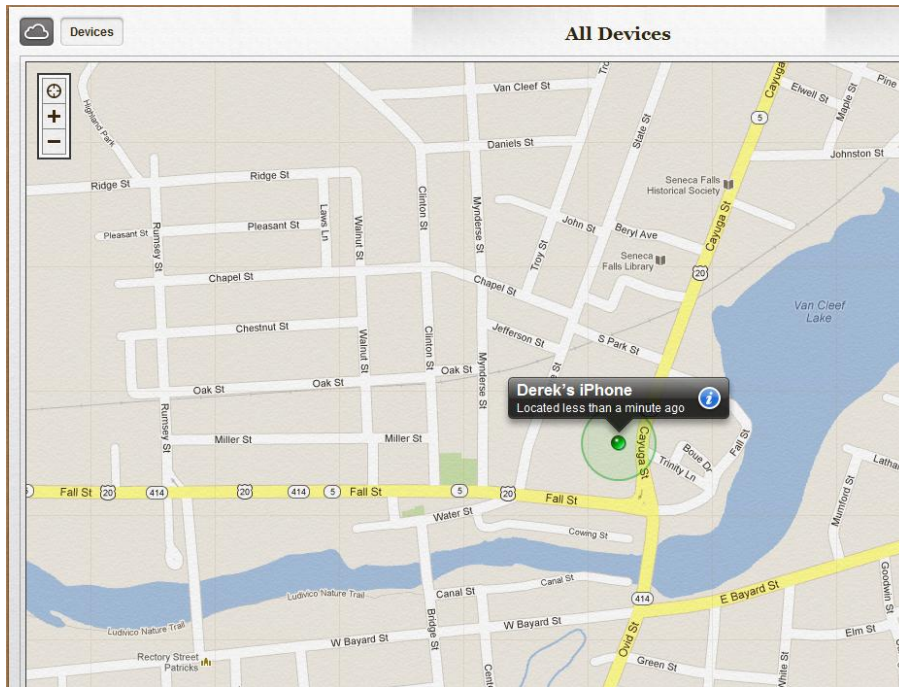


Click Find My iPhone.

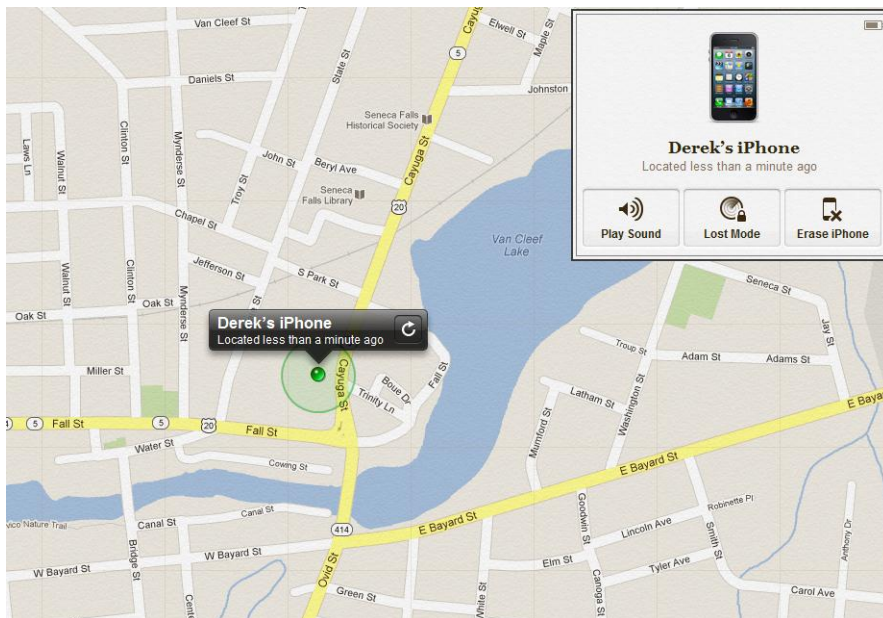




Soon, Find My iPhone should locate your iPhone, showing you exactly where it is on a map.

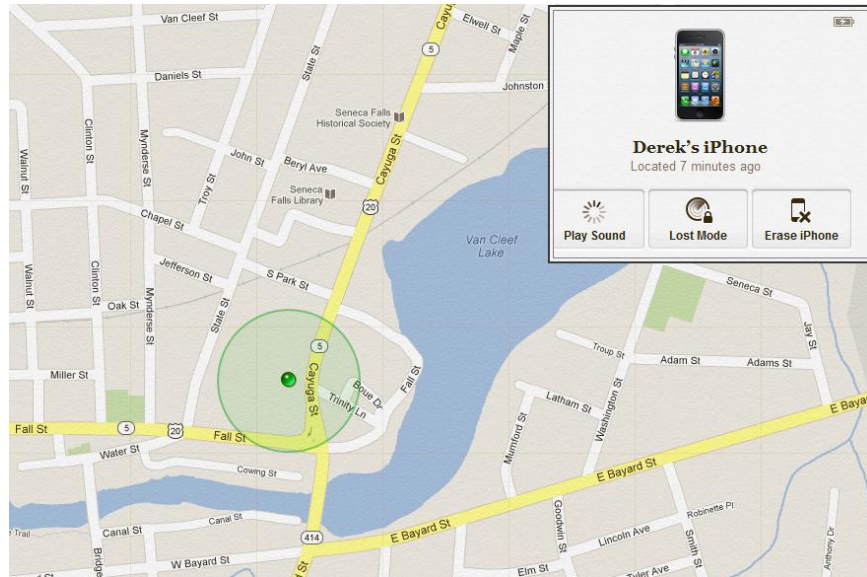


Select the little blue "i" to see what you can do from here. You'll notice three options, "Play Sound," "Lost Mode," or "Erase iPhone."

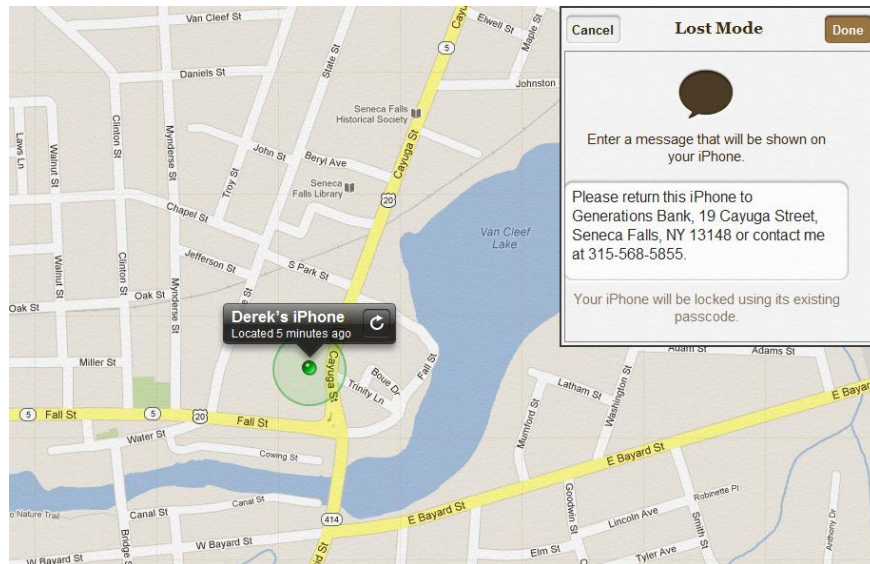




If you select “Play Sound,” your phone will be sent a message that plays a ringing tone. This will either alert bystanders to the location of your phone, or alert the phone holder that you’re aware of their location.

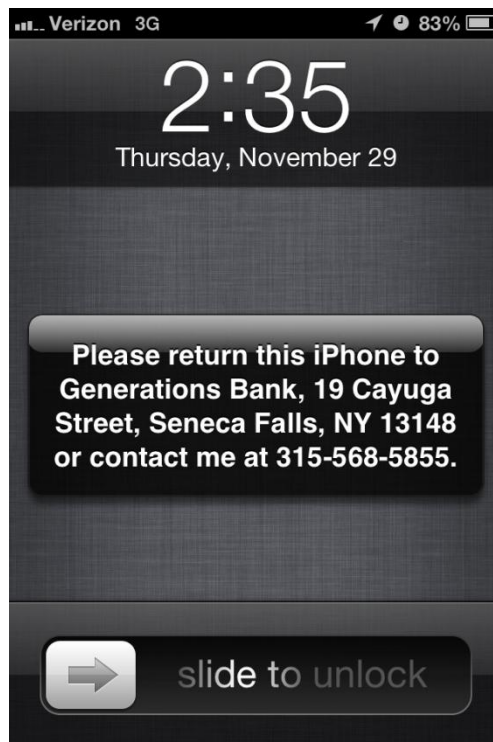


If you select “Lost Mode,” you’ll be prompted to compose a message to your lost phone. You may want to provide a location to meet, or a contact phone number.





Here's how the message looks on the lost iPhone's screen.



If you select "Erase iPhone," you'll see this warning. This will completely erase the contents of your phone, so please only choose "Erase iPhone" if you're certain that it's been stolen. This cannot be undone.
